DRAFT Water Quality Certification #WQC 2026-FERC-001 for Gilman Hydroelectric Project (FERC Project No. 2392) Dalton, New Hampshire and Gilman, Vermont

Available For Public Comment

In accordance with [RSA 485-A:12, III](#),¹ Ampersand Gilman Hydro, LP, (AGH or the Applicant), has filed an application with the NHDES for Water Quality Certification for Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) relicensing of the Gilman Hydroelectric Project (FERC Project No. 2392), located on the Connecticut River in the Village of Gilman (Town of Lunenberg) in Essex County, Vermont, and in the Town of Dalton in Coos County, New Hampshire. NHDES has reviewed the application and has prepared a draft certification, which is available for public comment:

Subject to conditions included in the certification, NHDES has determined that the Project operation will comply with surface water quality standards specified under [RSA 485-A:8](#)³ and NH Code of Administrative Rule [Env-Wq 1700](#).⁴ Therefore, NHDES proposes to grant the certification.
